Alejandro Cañadas earned his Licentiate in Economics from the Catholic University in Buenos Argentina (UCA), a Master in Business Administration with a concentration in Finance from the University of Dayton, a Ph.D. in Agricultural, Environmental and Development Economics from the Ohio State University, and an M.A. in Biblical Theology from John Paul the Great Catholic University.

Alejandro Cañadas has been an Associate Professor of Economics at the Bolte School of Business at Mount St. Mary's University since 2008. He teaches Corporate Finance, Financial Analysis, Applied Economic Analysis, The Economy of Francesco, The Economy of Love, and Ethics in Business among other classes at the undergraduate and MBA programs.

Alejandro Cañadas's current research is on Social Impact Investment and Integral Economics, Happiness and Wellbeing.

Dr. Cañadas is studying to become a Permanent Deacon at St. Mary's Seminary from the Archdioceses of Baltimore, Maryland, and his ordination will be in May 2026.
