INFORMATION ABOUT SCHOLARSHIPS

A limited number of full or partial scholarships (fee waivers) are available. Priority will be given to authors whose papers are accepted through the Call for Papers.

To proceed with your request, PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY and then access the form using the link below.

TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIP

Participation Scholarship: Covers the participation fee **only**. This scholarship grants free access to the conference; accommodation and any other expenses remain the responsibility of the participant.

Travel Scholarship: Covers **part** of the travel costs. Reimbursement will be made by bank transfer after the event, upon submission of valid travel receipts.

Important Information Regarding the Travel Scholarship

1. Before applying, we recommend carefully estimating your expected expenses, taking into account the following criteria:
 - Travel class: economy (flights, trains, or buses)
 - Departure airport/station: choose the most cost-effective option, even if it is not the closest to your departure location
 - Travel dates: your trip must be scheduled within 3 days before or after the event. Travel planned significantly outside this range (e.g., one month before or after) will not be considered
2. Based on your input and the overall budget available, the Foundation will assign a fixed reimbursement amount.

3. You are responsible for purchasing your own travel tickets.
4. If you are awarded a Travel Scholarship, you must pay the participation fee by the specified deadline. Failure to confirm your participation by then will result in reassignment of the scholarship.
5. Reimbursement will be processed only after the conference and no earlier than May 20.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1 letter of recommendation (from university professors, institutions, etc.)
Requirements:
The letter must be from a recognized institution or authority
It must be written on official letterhead
It must include a signature or/and an official stamp.
- If you are awarded a Travel Scholarship, please keep all receipts and supporting documentation for your expenses.

EVALUATION

The evaluation will be carried out based on the following criteria:

- PhD students and early-career researchers
- Participants from low- and middle-income countries
- Scholarly relevance (for accepted papers)
- Relevance to the conference themes
- Geographical distribution
- Gender balance
- Previous support from EoF

IMPORTANT DATES

- Application deadline: March 3
- Successful applicants will be notified via email by March 9

IMPORTANT NOTES

- If you are unable to travel, please inform us promptly at staff@francescoeconomy.org. Generally, in such cases, the scholarship will not be awarded. However, we are open to reviewing each situation individually.
- No additional financial support or subsidies are available.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a rolling basis until all funds are allocated. Early application is strongly recommended. Decisions of the selection committee are final and not subject to appeal.
